Reason for Change Improved Coolant

Improvement Better cooling system efficiency

Models/Serial Numbers Affected

Internal combustion engine equipment

PowerBoss is changing their coolant specification on all internal combustion engines. We now use PEAK GLOBAL LIFETIME ANTIFREEZE/COOLANT and require this type of coolant be used in any equipment sold back to **January 2010**. Please be sure equal parts of coolant and water are used when changing to this type of antifreeze.

Failure to complete this change may result in the engine warranty being void on the unit. If not already serviced or flushed please be sure this is executed on your unit, Make sure the mixture is accurate with 50/50 with coolant and water when changing. A warranty claim can be filed and PowerBoss will pay a flat fee of \$75.00 us dollars to complete this. We feel this change will help the engine perform more efficiently and may extend the life of the unit overall.
